



# Terms & Conditions

1. To qualify for participating in this contest, you must first complete the online registration form. Follow all instructions and complete the online registration form in its entirety.
2. Duplicate prizes will not be awarded. Judges' decisions will be final in all matters relating to the contest.
3. CSC reserves the right to suspend or cancel this contest should virus, bugs or other causes beyond its control corrupt the administration, security or proper judging of the contest. Submission of an entry constitutes your acceptance of the conditions of the contest.
4. The contest is open to students who are enrolled full-time for a two, three or four year course in an accredited college or institute or university in India.
5. All material provided on this website is for academic reference use only.
6. Winners will be notified via e-mail, and will be required to sign and return an affidavit of eligibility and release of liability/publicity within 30 days of notification (except where prohibited) or prize will be forfeited and may be awarded to an alternate winner on the basis of the criteria set forth herein.
7. Employment offers would be made to the first, second and third prize winners subject to following conditions:
  - Offer recipients complete their examinations in the first attempt clearing all backlogs (if any) before completing their final year
  - Offer recipients will not go through any other selection process
  - Offer recipients should be willing to work at a location chosen by the company
  - Offer recipients should be open to working on a platform chosen by the company
  - Offer recipients should be willing to sign standard CSC's service agreement for campus hires
  - Offer letters will contain the details of compensation, which will be awarded at the felicitation ceremony
